Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 20 March 2006 at 7.30pm in the Village Hall

Cllr Berry addressed the meeting, after agreement by councillors, regarding the mayors charity dinner and dance scheduled for Sat 22nd April 2006.

Minutes

Cllr Haddon wished it to be noted that the benchmarks were not formal and did not infringe on Ordnance Survey regulations. The minutes of the meetings held on 20 February 2006 were then agreed and signed.

Declarations of Interest None apparent.

Matters Arising

Beulah Fields Cllr Fisher reported that he had submitted a grant application to Humber Playing Fields with some queries being answered, awaiting outcome. Cllr Haddon had been in contact with Mr Whyatt, Cemex with follow up information regarding the facilities. A copy of her report was submitted to all councillors (copy with minutes). Cllr Haddon also suggested that other sources of grants be looked at for future.

Benchmarks Benchmarks received, Cllr Leaning to site.

Path to Horkstow Letter read out from Mr Norvock explaining that the councils request had been noted but he was not optimistic that the footpath link would be provided in the foreseeable future but would keep the parish council advised. Following discussion clerk to write to Mr Hill asking if use of Community Service a viable proposition also to explain that service/utility companies had dug it up in the past and not re-instated.

Flood Plan Cllr Haddon reported that parts of the plan were being consulted upon/approved by different agencies (Environmental Agency and North Lincs Council) prior to the final draft.

Highway Matters

Letter received from Mr Hill reporting that new nameplate for Horkstow Road had been ordered and would be erected on receipt.

Sluice Road footpath requested neighbourhood services to spray weedkiller on defective areas.

Spring neighbourhood service instructed to jet the surface water system again.

Clerk to write explaining that jetting needed east up the hill not particularly west, and the manhole cover on the grass verge opposite the allotments, up from the post office on the south side needed lifting.

Footpath High Street - telephone box to bus shelter needed clearing back.

Mr Pete Scott highways had agreed to attend meeting on 15th May 2006.

Playing Field No new information received from Mr Hudson. No report from Cllr Sherwood.

BT Proposals re Payphone Cllr Haddon reported that she had e-mailed English Heritage for advice but was waiting a reply, and had contacted Mr Rhyklak the conservation officer also awaiting information.

Web Site Following on from the lottery grant award Cllr Haddon and Clerk to liaise as to the way forward regarding the construction of the web site. It was hoped to have hyperlinks to other agencies.
