WARD NEWS FOR JUNE 2014

46 crimes were recorded in the Brigg and Wolds Ward in June 2014, of which 30 were in Brigg town. The average monthly total is around 43. There were 21 incidences of theft, 2 burglaries (none in a dwelling), 11 offences involving criminal damage (7 in Brigg), and 12 incidents where there was assault or harassment.

Other concerns addressed by the Brigg and Wolds Neighbourhood Police Team during June 2014

The greater proportion of the work of Neighbourhood Police Teams relates to public and individual needs and concerns that are not directly crime-related.

In June 2014, 172 concerns were responded to by the Brigg and Wolds team as follows -

Concerns about property	20
Concerns about individuals and safety	21
Concerns about behaviour	
Concerns about traffic	63

Individual incidents vary enormously in the amount of police time required to deal with them. In a good proportion of cases people's legitimate suspicions and concerns prove to be unfounded.

REPORTS FOR JUNE 2014 FROM YOUR LOCAL AREA

Brigg

Recorded crimes in June 2014

30 crimes were recorded in Brigg during the month - made up of:

- 3 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 2 x Theft in a dwelling
- 4 x Theft of a pedal cycle
- 4 x Theft from a (motor) vehicle
- 2 x Theft from a shop
- 3 x Theft (other)
- 2 x Common assault & Battery
- 7 x Criminal damage (to property)
- 1 x Harassment
- 2 x Homophobia



A total of 89 other incidents and matters of individual or community concern have been reported in June, including:

- 6 incidents where there was concern for the safety of individuals
- 2 reports of rowdy or nuisance behaviour
- 21 traffic related matters
- 13 other reports of suspicious activity

Wrawby

Recorded crimes in June 2014

- 1 x Burglary not in dwelling
- 1 x Theft in a dwelling
- 1 x Theft (other)

A caller reported concerns for a man on a motorway bridge. A broken down vehicle was also reported on the motorway. Police were also called to a civil dispute over an individual's personal belongings.

Elsham

No recorded crimes in June 2014

Police were called to six incidences of highway disruption – just one in the village (sheep on the road). An individual was arrested at Barnetby Top on drugs and money laundering charges. A suspicious vehicle was reported on Middlegate Lane. A vehicle was reported on the wrong carriageway at Barnetby Top, where a witness also reported a road traffic collision.

Barnetby

Recorded crimes in June 2014

- 1 x Assault causing actual bodily harm
- 1 x Burglary not in dwelling
- 1 x Theft of a pedal cycle
- 1 x Assault on a constable
- 1 x Criminal damage (to property)

Police were called on 34 other occasions, 23 of which involved traffic collisions, highway disruption or alleged traffic offences. Three callers reported concern for other people's safety.

Bonby

Recorded crimes in June 2014

1 x Theft in a dwelling 1 x Common assault & Battery

Both offences at the same address

Police were called to two civil disputes and in response to a sudden death.

Worlaby

Recorded crimes in June 2014

2 x Criminal damage

Police were called when a youth was seen in a private garden. Five calls related to concerns for the safety of individuals – on two occasions alarm pendants had been pressed in error.

Saxby All Saints

Recorded crimes in June 2014

1 x Theft (other) 1 x Harassment

Police were called about a suspicious vehicle on private land, also when an individual received malicious text message, and when a former partner was seen watching the caller's house.

Horkstow

Recorded crimes in June 2014

1 x Criminal damage

A report was received of a quad bike rider without a helmet.

South Ferriby

No recorded crimes in June 2014

Two calls related to the safety of a missing person. A youth was also reported throwing stones at a vehicle/ person at a kids community event.

Melton Ross and New Barnetby

Recorded crimes in June 2014

1 x Theft (other)

Ten reports were received about highway disruption. Two calls reported a possible abandoned vehicle.
